- Started our **Religious Education** unit about **Special Places**, thank you so much to everyone who emailed in a photo or brought in a picture of your special place, we loved sharing them and talking about places that are special to us, we thought of lots of words to describe why the places are so special to us such as: **quiet, peaceful, fun, exciting, beautiful, memories, family,**
- We have created some wonderful mini-beast **collages** in the style of Eric Carle, we created backgrounds for our work using different **paint techniques** and then created minibeasts by carefully ripping paper, thinking about the **colour, shape and size** that we needed.
- In Letters and Sounds we have recapped **the sounds:** ear, air, ure, er. We have worked hard to learn the **tricky words:** come, some
- We thought about how we could **describe** the minibeasts that we found on our Minibeast Hunt in the Forest School area and wrote 'What am I?' poems. We **sounded out** carefully using the **letters and sounds** that we have learnt, left **spaces** between words and checked that it made **sense!**
- In Maths we have practised recalling number bonds to 10 using the words **add, plus, equals, altogether, part, whole**
- In PE we learnt how to change the **speed and direction** that we are moving in to avoid bumping into other people/objects. We practised working as a **team** when playing team games.

- Go on a Mini beast hunt in your garden or whilst out and about. Draw and label the mini beasts that you find.
- Keep practising your letters and sounds and reading your reading book, you should be reading at least five times a week.
