This week in English, we have enjoyed becoming the characters 'Daisy' and 'Pipsqueak', from our book *Daisy Doodles*, acting out the story. We then looked at how the author used 'and' in the book to join words and sentences together and practiced this.

In Maths, we finished our unit of measuring and completed a task showing what we had learnt about measuring length, weight and volume. We then began to look at 3D shapes, using these to create repeated patterns.

In Science, we looked at seasonal changes and recapped what we knew about the four seasons. We then painted trees to represent the different seasons.
