This week we have continued our learning on the story of 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar.'

- In Maths we have been learning how to **halve** numbers; we compared it to **doubling** and talked about what we noticed. We **investigated** which numbers can be halved equally and which cannot. We used words such as: **half, less, take away, the same as, equals.**
- We talked about what makes a **healthy** lunchbox, we designed our own healthy lunchboxes and talked about the importance of a **balanced** diet.
- We were very excited to **observe** our class caterpillars **grow and change**, they have got much longer and bigger! We learnt about **life cycles** and created our own butterfly lifecycle out of playdough, we talked about each stage: **egg, caterpillar, chrysalis and butterfly.**
- In Letters and Sounds we have focussed reading and spelling **CCVC words.**
