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## Tarka class learning

In Geography, we learnt about greenhouse gases and the greenhouse effect. To understand how some heat and gas escapes and some gets 'trapped' in the Earth, we used the parachute on the playground and acted it out!

The children have been focusing on using capital letters and full stops consistently and correctly in their sentences. They enjoyed 'marking' mine and Miss Bennett's work and showing us where we had forgotten full stops or capital letters! We have also worked on joining words and clauses using 'and'.

We finished our maths unit on money this week. Tarka class impressed us with their understanding of the value of coins. They have been using 2ps, 5ps and 10ps to count in 2s, 5s and 10s and solve problems!
