This week in English, we have drawn story maps to help us remember the main parts of the story 'Grendal'. We have identified the nouns and verbs in the story and have learnt that a sentence must contain a noun and a verb.

In Maths, we have been using base ten to make two and three-digit numbers to help us recognise the place value of each digit in the number.

This term our Art focus is 'Landscape art'. We have talked about what landscape art is and identified the different types of landscapes in our local area.
