This week we have started a new topic 'Under the Sea'. We have started by thinking about the children's own experiences of going to the beach and have read the story 'Sally and the Limpet'.

- This week we have written a list of things that we would need to take the beach in our beach bag. We sounded out carefully and wrote down the sounds that we could hear.
- We have listened to the story 'Sally and the Limpet' and have acted it out in our new beach role-play area using words and phrases from the story.

- In Maths we have learnt about the numbers 19 and 20, and have represented them using Numicon, part-part whole, tens frames and objects. We also learnt about odd and even numbers.

- In Letters and Sounds we have recapped all of the sounds and words that we have learnt so far and have practised writing longer ccvc and cvcc words.

Please remember to read five times and record it in your reading diary.

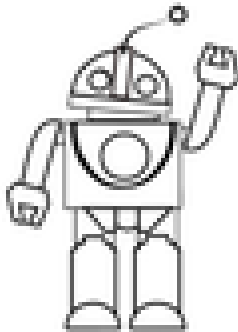
