This week we have continued our learning based on the story ' Mr Gumpy's Motor Car', we have ...

- Thought about how the story could have ended differently, we have written simple **sentences** using the **sounds** and **words** that we know.
- We have created vehicles with moving wheels using, **scissors**, **hole punches** and **split pins**.
- Practised writing the **long ladder letters**, we tried to start and finish each letter in the correct place. (l, I, j, u y, t)
- In PE we have learnt how to **roll and stop** a ball with **control**.
- We have explored **2d shapes**, we have investigated which shapes have **curved and straight edges** and have learnt the names of the shapes - **circle, rectangle, square, triangle, hexagon, pentagon**.
- We have recapped the sounds j v w x, and have practised **reading** and **writing words** using these **sounds**, we have learnt the tricky word '**her**'.
- Well done to everyone who dressed up for World Book Day, you all looked amazing, we loved hearing about your favourite books!
