



## Home Learning -

This week we have started learning about 'Growing', our text has been 'Jack and the Beanstalk'.

- We have acted out the story using small world and role play. We thought about the order of the story and tried to use key words and phrases in our story telling.
- We thought about why our Mummy's are special to us, we have created and written Mothers day cards to give to them on Mothering Sunday.
- Practised writing the **long ladder letters**, we tried to start and finish each letter in the correct place. (l, I, j, u y, t)
- In PE we have learnt how to **throw and catch** a ball with **control**.
- We have explored **3d shapes**, we looked for the shapes in the school environment, investigated which shapes have **curved and flat edges** and have learnt the names of the shapes - **cube, cuboid, cylinder, cone, sphere, pyramid**.
- We have recapped the sounds ch, sh, th, ng and have practised **reading and writing words** using these **sounds**, we have learnt the tricky word '**are**'.
- We were delighted to see that the **daffodil bulbs** that we **planted** in the garden have now **flowered!** We talked about the parts of a daffodil and made careful **observational drawings** of them using pastels.
