Job purpose including main duties and responsibilities: To work under the guidance of the teaching and senior staff, within an agreed system of supervision, to:

- Implement agreed range of activities with individuals/groups of children, either within or outside
 of the nursery
- Assist the senior staff in the whole observation, assessment and planning cycle
- Management/preparation of resources to support an enabling learning environment, both indoors and outdoors
- Generally assist children in undertaking both adult directed and child initiated activities, interacting with them to support their learning and development
- Regularly contributing towards written observations of a child's progress, whilst maintaining confidentiality at all times
- Collating evidence to support a child's progress towards learning outcomes
- Demonstrate an ongoing commitment to the safeguarding of children and young people

We are seeking to appoint a dedicated person who will be able to work closely with the school staff, other agencies and parents in order to support the needs of our children from age 2 to 5 Excellent interpersonal skills and organisation will be desirable for this role. To apply, you will be:

- An enthusiastic individual who enjoys working with young children
- Have a Level 2 or above in early childhood studies (or willingness to train in this field)
- Be flexible and able to manage set tasks independently
- Willing to be a team player in our friendly and supportive pre-school;
