## Tarka class learning

We finished our Pop Art backgrounds this week, ready to add a moving plane through the use of a lever or slider in DT next week.

In maths, we looked at ordinal numbers (1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> etc.) and discussed when we might use these numbers. E.g. dates, positions in a line or race. The children used ordinal numbers during our sports day practice.
