This week we have continued our learning about Growing based on the traditional tale 'Jack and the Beanstalk'. This week we have...

- Imagined what might be at the top of our beanstalk and have drawn and labelled a picture, there were so many wonderful ideas such as sweet shops, volcanoes, dragons, football pitches and unicorn lands!
- In Maths we have learnt about capacity, we have filled bottles with water, plant pots with soil and buckets with sand and have used vocabulary such as full, empty, half full, half empty, nearly full and nearly empty. We investigated how many smaller containers filled a larger container.

- This half term in Letters and Sounds we will be recapping the sounds that we have previously learnt, this week we have practised oo, oo, oi, ow. We are practising to ensure that our tall letters are tall and short letters are short when writing them.
- We loved sharing everyone's favourite books and guessing which book character your story spoons were to celebrate World Book Day, well done everyone for making such an effort to dress up you all looked brilliant!
