



Home Learning - Week 25

This week we have continued our learning about *Growing* based on the story 'Jaspers Beanstalk'. This week we have...

- Written instructions for how to plant bean seeds. We sounded out carefully using the letters and sounds that we know and tried hard to remember to leave a space between each word.
- In Maths we have learnt how to weigh objects using direct comparison, and using balancing scales.
- We planted bean seeds and talked about what we need to do to help them grow.
- In Letters and Sounds we have been recapping the sounds that we have previously learnt, this week we have practised ear, air, ure, er. We are practising to ensure that our tall letters are tall and short letters are short when writing them.
- We used loose parts to create spring pictures, we talked about what we had created giving reasons for why we had chosen each object in our picture.
- In PSHE we learnt about how germs spread, we did a fun experiment using glitter to represent germs and watched how it travelled when we forgot to wash our hands.
