Thank you to those of you who have made a poster to promote ways to reduce the effects of global warming. We have shared and displayed them in class and the children have been interested to learn more about what global warming is and how we humans can help our Earth! We listened to some stories about polar bears and how their habitat is becoming warmer and melting the ice. We also started learning about the difference between **weather** and **climate**.

In Religion and worldviews we have started our new unit, 'Who is Muslim and how do they live'. We thought about things that are important to us and how, Allah is important to Muslim people. We learnt that in the Quran they have 99 names for Allah and that the name Allah is God in Arabic.
