This week we have been learning all about royal things and the King's coronation.

This week the children have:

- Read 'The kings pants' and 'The Kings coronation'
- Baked cakes and decorated them with red and blue icing.

- Decorated, coloured and cut out a crown to wear.
- Played with red, blue and white rice. The children filled different sized cups with the rice using language such as, "The cup is full... The cup is half full" etc.

- Played in the home corner which is decorated with bunting, paper plates/cups, flags etc. The children pretended to have their own tea part.
