

## Home Learning - Week 30

This week we have enjoyed our learning based on the story 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar.'

- This week we have read the story of the Hungry Caterpillar and had great fun acting it out in sequence using words and phrases from the story.
- In Maths we have been learning how to double numbers 0-10 and have used vocabulary such as add, plus, altogether, equals, double, the same as, more. The children created some wonderful doubling butterflies by printing and noticing how many spots there were when they were doubled.
- We have strengthened the muscles in our hands by using hole-punches to punch holes in paper leaves.
- The children have made incredibly detailed observational drawings of bugs set in resin. They used sketching pencils and learnt how to shade.
- We have sequenced and labelled the life cycle of a butterfly.
- In Letters and Sounds we have focussed on the sounds 'sh, ch, th, ng. and the tricky words: little, were, there.
