Tarka class learning

Year 1 enjoyed being tree detectives, observing and identifying trees by looking at their leaves and blossom. They learnt the difference between deciduous and evergreen trees.

In English, we recapped what a verb is and learnt about imperative verbs (bossy verbs used in instruction writing). The children had a go at writing some instructions to get the Woolly Mammoth into the bath. We also recapped question and exclamation marks and used these in our writing.

In maths, year 1 have represented arrays using repeated addition and used their counting in 2s, 5s and 10s to solve problems. Year 2 have used arrays to find fact families and learnt how to use their knowledge of multiplication to help them solve division problems.

Tarka class asked questions about the UK and Brazil, which we will answer over the next few weeks to help us with our enquiry question: Would you rather live in the UK or Brazil? We recalled our previous Geography learning about the equator and used Google Earth to find the UK and Brazil.

In art, the children looked at work by the Brazilian pop artist Romero Britto. They talked about what they liked, disliked and the patterns, shapes and colours they could see.
