This week we have started learning about how Christians Celebrate Easter. We have...

- Learnt about how and why Christians celebrate Easter and the things that we do at home with our families at this time of year.
- Thought about symbols associated with Easter and what they represent. We have created our own Easter Cards and written them.
- In Maths we have learnt about measuring time, we have explored how things change over time such as ourselves, animals and through cooking. We have taken part in timed challenges, sequenced events in time and have learnt the days of the week.
- We listened carefully, followed instructions and learnt how to cut and fold paper to make Easter Baskets.
- We have made observations how our seeds are growing and have noticed what is changing.
- In Letters and Sounds we have recapped all of the sounds that we have learnt so far and have been working hard to write captions using what we know. We have worked hard to learn the tricky words: they, are, all.
- In PSHE we learnt about why sleep is important to keep us healthy. We talked about our bed time routines and what helps us sleep well.
