Science Day:

A huge thankyou to the parents who gave up their time to support us in running a Science morning. They helped our students see the real-world applications of science in ways that were engaging and relatable. Their passion and dedication left a lasting impression, and we know many of our students walked away with a renewed curiosity and appreciation for science in everyday life.

Optometrist Talk

The children explored the structure and function of the eye, learning how sunlight affects vision and the importance of eye protection. They discovered how lenses help us see clearly and were amazed to learn the eye is the second most complex organ in the body.

Midwife Talk

The midwife explained baby development from birth, using fruit sizes for comparison. She discussed the role of the umbilical cord, and how babies' skin colour changes after birth.





Pharmacist Session

Children learned that medicine dosages vary per person. The pharmacist demonstrated how antibiotics fight infections using a vinegar and baking soda experiment, emphasising the importance of correct dosage.

EV Battery Demonstration

A parent explained how electric car batteries work, their recyclability, and environmental benefits. The children learned about battery materials like lithium and nickel, and why electric cars, though quieter, require extra caution near roads.

Carpenter Workshop

The carpenter shared how trees grow and transport nutrients. He brought a 3,000-year-old wood sample and explained the roles of bark, sapwood, and heartwood, as well as the uses of hardwood vs. softwood in carpentry.





Net Zero & Climate Talk

A parent discussed insulation, renewable energy sources, and the environmental impact of fossil fuels. The session encouraged children to adopt energy-saving habits and consider sustainable choices to combat climate change.

Scientist

Our scientist demonstrated a plasma ball and infrared camera to show how electricity and heat travel. She explained scientific tools used to observe space and stars.









Doctor

A local doctor explained how the body works, focusing on nerves, muscles, and reflexes. Children observed a reflex test using a hammer on the knee, demonstrating how the nervous system responds.
