

Home Learning -

This week we have continued our learning on the story of 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar.'

- We have created our own healthy fruit smoothie. We learnt how to prepare the fruit and blend it. We talked about the colours, textures and tastes of the fruits and vegetables that we used.
- We wrote instructions for how to make fruit smoothies using the letters and sounds that we have learnt. We talked about what we did, first, next, after that and finally.
- In Maths we have been learning how to halve numbers; we compared it to doubling and talked about what we noticed. We investigated which numbers can be halved equally and which cannot. We used words such as: half, less, take away, the same as, equals.
- We created our own junk model caterpillars our of egg boxes, we added legs, antenna and coloured them in spots and stripes!
- We were very excited to watch out class caterpillars grow and change, they have got much longer and bigger!
- In Letters and Sounds we have focussed reading and spelling CCVC words, we have learnt to read the tricky words: like and have,
