Welcome back, we hope you have all enjoyed a fun filled half term holiday; we have loved hearing about what the children have been up to, thank you so much to those of you who emailed in photographs, we have really enjoyed looking at them all this week.

- This week we have written a list of things that we would need to take the beach in our beach bag. We sounded out carefully and wrote down the sounds that we could hear.

- In Maths we have learnt about the numbers 15,16,17,18, and have represented them using Numicon, part-part whole, tens frames and objects.
- In PE we have practised some of the events that will be in our Sports Morning next week and have done some running races.
- In Letters and Sounds we have recapped all of the sounds and words that we have learnt so far and have practised writing longer ccvc and cvcc words.
