The children have had a lovely first week back; settling into routines, sharing their holiday news and catching up with their friends. In Forest school, we learnt that all plants come from seeds and looked at lots of different seeds and discussed what was similar and what was different. We planted some Nasturtium seeds and are really excited to watch them grow and then we made some predictions about where we expect to see the roots and stem emerge from on the seed, when it germinates.
