Our topic this week is 'All about me!'. This week we have read books about the body and our senses. The children learnt a new song called 'parts of the body' by 'Caitie's Classroom'.

Activities/provision this week:

- We drew around one of the children on a large piece of paper. The children then labelled the different parts of the body by placing pictures on the outline e.g. hands, eyes, mouth, feet.
- 'How tall am I?' activity We measured the children using string and the chalk board. We compared the children's heights using mathematical language e.g. tall, short.
- Colour mixing We read 'Mix it up' and then the children experimented with colour mixing. The children painted each of their hands a different colour then mixed them together to make a new one. They printed their hands onto paper.
- Colour monster activity We drew the 'mixed up' colour monster onto a
 large tuff tray and filled it with different coloured pom poms. The
 children helped the colour monster by sorting the pom poms into groups.
 The children used tweezers to sort the pom poms and match them to the
 monster of the matching colour.
- We read stories about our senses smell, taste, smell, touch.

Phonics: Instrumental sounds

This term our phonics focus is instrumental sounds! We will be experimenting playing with a variety of instruments. We will practice playing the instruments loud, quiet, fast, slow etc.

Maths: Sorting

We have been learning to sort objects into different groups and describe them e.g. sort by shape, colour or size.

Next week the topic is: Harvest
