



## Home Learning

This week we have continued to learn about Traditional Tales. Our text this week has been 'Little Red Riding Hood'.

We have ...

- In phonics, we have learnt to recognise, read and write the **digraphs**: oi, ow, or, ur, we have learnt the **tricky word**: **you**
- We have explored different ways of joining junk modelling materials together using masking tape, glue, glue sticks and split pins to make a basket for Little Red Riding Hood. We used vocabulary such as: **attach, secure, tear, rip, holepunch, edge, fold**.
- Practised writing the 'one-armed robot **letters**'- h b, k, p and have tried hard to remember to start and finish in the correct place. We tried hard to position **ascenders and descenders** correctly on the line.
- Thought about how we could describe the Wolf using words such as: **scary, frightening, fierce, pointy claws, ravenous, mean, sharp teeth, vicious**. They wrote a WANTED poster using simple captions and sentences using the letters and sounds we have learnt.
- In Maths we have started to learn about repeated patterns. We identified patterns on everyday objects, identified, extended and created our own repeating AB and ABC patterns. We described patterns using vocabulary such as: **pattern, repeated, rule, shape, size, colour, extend, identify**.
