This week in English we have been learning to write a setting description, we have learnt that a setting description tells us when and where a story takes place. We have used the book 'Grandad's Island' for inspiration and have written some noun phrases to describe what we could see and what we might hear in the jungle.

In Maths, we have been finding coins to make different amounts and the using a number line to help us find change.
