Our topic this week is 'The Gingerbread Man'. We have read lots of different versions of 'The Gingerbread Man'. Thank you to parents/carers who sent in their stories from home.

Activities/provision this week:

- Gingerbread Man craft The children have loved making their own gingerbread man with craft materials.
- Gingerbread Playdough The children used pretend baking trays, real rolling pins and gingerbread man shaped cutters to make their own gingerbread man.
- Gingerbread themed home corner The children pretended to make gingerbread themed foods and hot chocolates.
- Gingerbread Man small world play The children acted out the story using farm animals, puppets, a farmhouse and pretend grass/water.
- Decorating a gingerbread man On Wednesday the children decorated a gingerbread man with icing and ate them for snack.
- Making a bridge for the Gingerbread Man We talked about the
 ending of the story and how it could have been different. The children
 used different construction materials to make a 'bridge' for the
 gingerbread man so he wouldn't get eaten by the fox.
- Baking the Gingerbread Man On Friday the children worked together to bake gingerbread men and decorate them with icing.
- Gingerbread Man loose parts The children used loose parts e.g. pipe cleaners and buttons to decorate a Gingerbread Man.

Phonics: Body percussion

This term our phonics focus is Body Percussion! The children are learning to develop their awareness of sounds and rhythm. They have been using their bodies to make different sounds e.g. tapping, stomping, clicking, clapping. We have been practicing making sounds slow, fast, loud and quiet.

Maths:

The children have been learning how to:

- Try and guess the number of objects by just looking at them (1-5 objects)
- Recognise how many objects are in a group without having to count them one by one (1-5 objects).

Next week the topic will continue to be: The Gingerbread Man!
