Thank you for the beautiful poppies bought into school this week. We have put them on display in the cloakroom. We discussed Remembrance Day, and the children enjoyed creating more poppy art using tissue paper, sequins, buttons and pom poms.

This week in English, we have collected animal facts and learnt how to use spider diagrams to record the facts we collected. We have recapped what nouns and verbs are by sorting word cards and using them to write simple sentences, we also explored verb tenses and practised writing them in the present tense.

In Maths, we have been adding 9, using a mental method of adding 10 then subtracting 1. We also discovered how we can use the same method for similar numbers, 19, 29, 39 and use this method for subtracting 9.

In Geography, we explored the human and physical geography of our school area and recorded our findings to later compare to a different area of the UK.
