This week we have started our learning about Traditional Tales. Our text this week has been 'Little Red Riding Hood.

We have ...

- In phonics, we have learnt to recognise, read and write the digraphs: oo, oo, ar, we have learnt the tricky word: **my**
- We enjoyed dressing up and acting out and using small word toys to retell the story of Little Red Riding Hood in the correct sequence, using words and phrases from the story.
- Practised writing the 'one armed robot letters'- r, n, m, h and have tried hard to remember to start and finish in the correct place.
- We learnt how to attach different materials together using glue, Sellotape, split pins and masking tape to make paper flowers.
- We practised our sketching skills by doing drawings of the wolf and explored pressing lightly and hard with the pencil.
