



## Home Learning -

This week we have been learning about how and why people celebrate Easter

- We looked at different **symbols** associated with Easter and why they were important, such as **hot cross buns, cross, Easter Eggs, basket, lambs, chicks, daffodils, chocolate and church.**
- We created Easter Cards.
- Practised writing the **long ladder letters**, we tried to start and finish each letter in the correct place. (l, I, j, u y, t)
- In PE we have learnt how to work together as a team when playing **parachute games.**
- We have recapped the sounds or, ur, ow, oi, and have practised **reading and writing words** using these **sounds**, we have learnt the tricky word 'so'
- Practised our **cutting and folding** skills to make an Easter Basket, we had to concentrate very hard to **cut and fold accurately.**
- We **listened** carefully to **two -step instructions** when making Easter Chocolate Nests, we can't wait to eat them!
