Tarka class learning

Tarka class have enjoyed seeing each other and sharing news of holidays this week!

In English, we started to learn the pattern of our new story *Orion and the Dark*. We discussed our own fears and recorded what we liked about the story.

In maths, we recapped what we already know about time. Year 1 recalled their knowledge of o'clock and half past. They then timed themselves doing activities in class and outside and recorded their results. Year 2 impressed us by telling the time to o'clock, half past and quarter to. We started learning to tell the time in five minute intervals. This was a challenge, so please keep practising at home!

We learnt that the UK is made up of four countries: England; Scotland; Wales and Northern Ireland. Tarka class located and identified each country on a map of the UK. We began to learn about the capital cities and famous landmarks.

In our provision activities, the children have enjoyed building models using Sticklebricks; creating a rainforest using small world loose parts; and using watercolours to paint a rainforest scene.
