Reading reminder

Our whole school expectation is that parents support their child to practising reading at home five times per week. This could be 5-10 minutes of reading, five times across the week. These reads can be logged on the Boom Reader app or website. Thank you for your support.

Spring term homework

In the new term, year 6 children will be given one piece of maths or English homework every week. They will need to give this in on Thursdays. If they forget it, they can bring it on the Friday. If they do not complete this, the expectation will be for them to complete it on Friday lunchtime. The activities will consolidate one skill that they have learned that week. They should be able to complete the simple activity independently and in a short amount of time - this mimics what they will be given for all subjects in September, and is part of becoming 'secondary ready'.
