

Home Learning - Week 19

- This week we have continued our learning based on the story 'Mr Gumpy's Motor Car'. You can listen to the story being read here: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=UDqqjccb5KE
- We have learnt how to use spilt pins and hole punches to make moving parts.
- In Maths we have continued to learn about patterns. We have extended and created patterns in straight lines, squares and in circles.
- We strengthened the muscles in our hands by creating woven wheels using wool and collage materials.
- We wrote a sentence using the sounds and words that we have learnt to describe what was happening in a picture from the story. We were amazed with how well the children managed this!
- Lots of children chose to write signs and labels for the vehicles that they made in the construction area, well done everyone!
- We explored printing using circular wheel shapes and tried to make repeating patterns.
- Learnt the digraphs or, ur, oi, ow, and practised reading and writing cvc words using these sounds. We also learnt to read the tricky word: my.
