This week we have had great fun acting out and learning the story 'The Gingerbread Man'. We have ...

- Written a sentence to describe the Gingerbread Man, we rehearsed the sentence we wanted to write, counted the number of words in the sentence and then sounded it out carefully.
- Explored subtracting from numbers 6,7,8,9,10. We used vocabulary such as less than, subtract, less, equals, take away.
- Followed instructions to bake Gingerbread Men and decorated them.
- Investigated what would happen if the Gingerbread Man fell into different liquids such as: milk, lemonade, oil and water and observed what happened.
- We have learnt the digraphs ai, ee, igh and have practised writing cvc words using these sounds.

Home Learning Task:

Practise reading real/non real words in the game 'Rubbish or Treasure using the sounds that we have learnt so far in Phase 3.
