## Barum class learning

This week in English we have started our new sequence, story writing using the text 'Augustus and his Smile' written by Catherine Raynor. We have discussed our likes, dislikes, puzzles and patterns in the story, we have drawn a story map and learnt the story using actions. We made a tiger mask and acted out telling the story as the Character Augustus.

In Math's we went on a shape hunt around the classroom and school grounds looking for 3D shaped objects. We have learnt the language of edges, vertices and faces and counted the edges and vertices on various 3D shapes.

This week in PE, we stared our Dance unit. We read the story Penguin Small and explored moving as a penguin, we then worked in groups and choreographed a short sequence of penguin steps.
