



## Home Learning

- We have learnt about our Oceans and how they are affected by **pollution**. We learnt about the **Great Pacific Garbage Patch and micro plastics**.

- We wrote 'What am I?' poems to describe sea creatures. We sounded out carefully and wrote sentences to describe the sea creature.
