- Been on a mini beast hunt in the forest school area of our school and discovered lots of mini beasts. We made careful observations of what they looked like, what they were doing and where they lived.
- Recapped how to subvertise numbers up to 5 and explored ways of making 5 using fives frames, numicon, and the part part whole image.
- Represented mini beasts using loose parts and talked about our creations.
- In Letters and Sounds we have recapped all of the ur, oi, ow sounds that we have learnt so far and have been working hard to write captions using what we know. We have worked hard to learn the tricky words: have, like
