This week we have continued our learning around the story of Jack and the Beanstalk.

This week we have...

- Thought of words to describe what the giant looks, sound, smells and behaves like and have written a poster to warn other villagers of him.
- Worked in small groups to make torn paper collages of the giant, the children thought carefully about the shapes and sizes of paper that they needed for his body and clothes and added wool and buttons.
- Created our own Giant Cress Heads, we can't wait to watch his hair grow!
- In Maths we have learnt to compare objects by height using words such as tall, taller, tallest, short, shorter, shortest.
- In Letters and sounds we have focused on the sounds ch, sh, th, ng and have been reading and writing longer ccvc and cvcc words using these sounds.

Find three objects around your house. Can you arrange them in order from shortest to tallest? Try again, this time with five objects. You can use words such as short, shorter, shortest, tall, taller, tallest?
