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Tarka home learning

We have had a fantastic week. In English, we have continued with our story sequence, looking specifically at using descriptive language in our writing. We then created a new class story, following the events of 'Sylvia and Bird' with new characters.

In Maths we have continued our learning on money. This week we have used our new knowledge of counting in twos and tens to count out money to pay for items. We then moved on to using a mixture of coins to make amounts in different ways.

In PE we started our gymnastics sequence. We learnt different styles of jumps, and practiced how to do this safely on the equipment. In Science, we recapped the parts of a flowering plant and then looked at the different parts of a tree, and the difference between evergreen and deciduous trees. In our Geography learning, we used Google Earth to explore where we live in the world, and compared the different features that we might find in towns or the countryside.
