We have had a lovely first week back for this half term. This week in English we started a new sequence for writing a recount. We explored the book *My Day at the Zoo*, and the language used when writing about events in chronological order.

In Maths, we revisited measuring, learning how to use a ruler to accurately measure how long or tall something is in centimeters. We then used our measurements to compare objects.

In PE we had fun learning how to dribble a football using control. We have also explored internet safety this week, having a class discussion about how to stay safe online and what we should do if we see something that upsets us. This week in History, we talked about what History is and what Historians do. We made our history badges ready to become Historians. First, we found out who the Victorians were. Then, we looked at pictures of Queen Victoria and produced some fantastic sketches of her.
