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Tarka class learning

This week Tarka class used their designs and drew the motifs for their cushions onto felt and cut them out. Year 2 started sewing their motif onto their material. All the children enjoyed practicing their sewing skills to add colour to an Easter decoration.

In English, we wrote our class version of Stuck. The year 2 pupils read and edited their work, focussing on their punctuation and spelling. Year 1 revisited using conjunctions 'and' and 'but' in their sentences.

In maths, the children have played lots of board games to practice subtraction. Year 1 focused on using a number line to subtract. Year 2 made their own subtraction board game. We have also been counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.

Year 2 enjoyed carrying out an investigation in science, testing which materials would be suitable to make a bath mat. They decided we would need to test to see if each material was soft and absorbent. In art we have been exploring adding texture to paint.

The children enjoyed taking part in the Comic Relief sporting activities organised by the year 6 children and they all looked fantastic their sporty outfits. They also enjoyed eating some cake - thank you for all your donations!
