This week we have continued our learning about Growing based on the traditional tale 'Jack and the Beanstalk'.

This week we have...

- Talked about the character of the Giant and have written a WANTED poster to describe him using the letters, sounds and words that we know.
- In Maths we have continued to learn about 2d and 3d shapes. We have tried to make 3d shapes out of construction kits and talked about what 2d shapes we can see in 3d shapes.
- We have made observations of how our cress Giant Heads are growing. We have started an investigation to find out why plants need water by placing white flowers in coloured water, we can't wait to see what happens.
- We practised our cutting skills by creating our own very tall beanstalks.
- This half term in Letters and Sounds we will be recapping the sounds that we have previously learnt, this week we have practised ai, ee, igh, oa. We are practising to ensure that our tall letters are tall and short letters are short when writing them.
