This week we have been learning all about the beach! We read books including 'Clean up', 'The storm whale' and 'The magic beach'.

This week the children have:

- Taken part in our EYFS sports day! Thank you to everyone who attended on Wednesday.
- Made a sensory 'beach' themed bottle. They put blue water, sand, sea animals etc. in an empty milk bottle with an adult. We talked about different things we would see at the beach.
- Made a rainbow fish! The children rolled up bits of tissue paper and glued them onto their own rainbow fish.
- Played a game called 'land or sea'. The children put animals into two groups depending on whether they live in the land or sea.
- Made a jelly fish using card and tissue paper. The children cut a circle out of card and glued tissue paper underneath to make the tentacles.
- Painted and decorate a treasure chest ready for our pirate topic starting next week.
