This week our topic has been Traditional Tales. We have been reading different versions of the story 'Goldilocks and the three bears'.

Activities this week at pre-school:

- Porridge tasting The children tasted different flavoured porridge. The children then voted which flavour they liked the best.
- Goldilocks and the three bears kitchen role play The children acted out the story in the role play area. They had three different sized bowls, spoons and chairs. There have been teddy bears and a goldilocks puppet in the home corner.
- We made bear faces using cork boards as the face and loose parts as the facial features. The children used, lollypop sticks, pom poms, buttons etc.
- The children made a bed for goldilocks out of different objects and materials. We talked about what would make a good bed. They decided if the bed was too hard, too soft or just right.
- Tasting activity The children used toast and fruit to make a bear face. They had bananas, raisins etc.
- Maths activity The children sorted objects into three categories small, medium and large. We talked about what other features they had.
- We acted out the story at circle time using different props bowls, chairs etc.
