Funding information for Summer Term

In order to access 30 hour funding from Summer Term 2023 (which for funding purposes starts on 1st April 2023), parents need to have applied to HMRC through their Government Gateway Account and received a code by 31st March 2023. Any codes with an 'eligible from' date of 1st April onwards will not be funded in Summer 2023.

It is important that children who are newly funded, or who move to a new setting from 1st April 2023, still have an eligible code as the Grace Period will not apply. The Grace Period does not apply to children who want to increase from the universal hours to extended hours when eligibility has ended either.
