

# 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2023

This week we have been learning all about the beach! We read books including 'Clean up', 'The storm whale' and 'The magic beach'.

#### This week the children have:

- Made ice-cream out of playdough. They made different coloured playdough to represent the flavours. They made cones out of card and decorated them.
- Painted a beach scene as a group. They painted a beach for the display using blue and yellow paint. Then they glued different beach scene pictures down on either the sand or sea. We discussed which things belong where.
- Learnt about keeping our beaches clean. They cleaned out rubbish from a sea scene in the tuff tray. They also untangled the sea animals in the water.
- Played with a beach dress up assault course. The children had to stop and each cone and try to put on a beach related item, for example, sun hat, sunglasses etc.
- Played with our water fountain. They observed how the water changed and was powered by solar energy.
- Played in our beach role play area, dressing up, playing with sand, playing in the wooden small play boat.
- Played with a sensory beach scene tuff tray. The children mixed shaving foam with blue paint. They also played with toy fish, boats and people.
