Home Learning

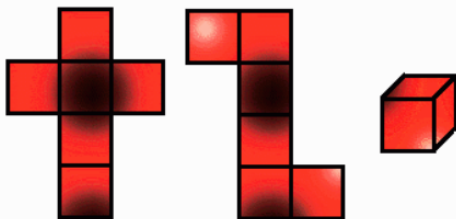
Reading
