This week in English we have been exploring poems with our new text 'A Book of the Sea' by Nicola Davis. We noticed that some poems we read had rhyming words, some had alliteration and some did not rhyme. We have learnt that poems can be about anything such as objects, animals, people, places or emotions and they describe what they are about.

In RE we explored what it is like inside a Church, we discussed what makes a Church a sacred place for some people and why it is special to them. We discovered that there are many different ways of being Christian.
