



Home Learning -

We hope you had an enjoyable half-term, we have loved hearing about what the children did, thank you to those of you who emailed in photos, unfortunately we have been unable to look at them due to our Internet not working this week, we hope to be able to share them next week. This week our learning has been based on the story 'Mr Gumpy's Motor Car'.

- Created our own **story maps** to retell the story of Mr Gumpy's motor car, we thought carefully about what happened at the **beginning, middle and end** of the story and added **key words** and **labels**.
- Explored **printing** wheel shapes into **paint**, we were interested in the **different sized circles** and how they fitted inside one another.
- Dipped wheels into paint and explored **printing straight, curved and zig zag** marks.
- We **investigated** ramps and worked out how to make cars **travel faster** and **further** by using more or less force and changing the **height** of the ramps.
- Practised writing the **long ladder letters**, we tried to start and finish each letter in the correct place. (l, I, j, u y, t)
- We have learnt the sounds ear, air, ure, er and have practised **reading** and **writing words** using these **sounds**.
