- Recapped how to subertise numbers up to 5 and explored ways of making 10 using tens frames, numicon, and the part part whole image.
- Helped out in the EYFS garden, with weeding, tidying, sweeping and sorting.
- Created collages of mini beasts in the style of Eric Carle using handmade papers that we painted ourselves.
- In Letters and Sounds we have learnt the tricky words: like, have, come, some.
