In phonics, the new graphemes we learnt this week are:

u_e (cube) aw (saw) ey (monkey)

We have learned about 3D shapes in maths. The children can now identify cubes, cuboids, cylinders, cones, pyramids, spheres and prisms!

In our Religion and Worldviews learning, we had fun creating stained glass windows, representing different parts of the Christian story of Creation.
