This week the children have written their own instructions based on How to Wash a Woolly Mammoth. They impressed us with their humorous ideas.

In maths, year 1 continued to develop confidence in selecting and adding coins to pay for items in our toy shop and they worked on understanding the value of 5, 10 and 20 pound notes. They also started to tell the time to the hour and half past the hour. Year 2 children estimated and recorded time and represented o'clock, half past, quarter to and quarter past on an analogue clock.

We learnt more about the Amazon rainforest in Geography. Tarka class have enjoyed creating rainforest collages and information posters to display their learning. We also began our Romero Britto inspired collages. In music, we listened to our song 'In the Groove' in the style of Latin music (we've already listened to it in a blues and bhangra style) and we played along with our glockenspiels.
